Dear Librarian:

I am trying to gather information on my ancestor, Samuel Shortridge, who fought in the Revolutionary War. I obtained a note to specific references (noted in a DAR membership application) found in your library and am wondering if you could make a copy of the information and send it to me.

Reportedly, Samuel Shortridge (born c.1756, died 8Jul1823, marr. Sarah Scholl) served as an Indian-Fighter in Capt. Charles Hazelrigg's company, Fayette Co., (KY) Virginia militia, under command of Col. Daniel Boone, in general George Rogers Clark's expedition against the Indians, on the Scioto River, in Ohio, 1782, after the battle of Blue Licks. He entered service: 24Oct1782, and was discharged: 25Nov1782. I am looking for confirmation of this, and any other reference to his participation in the history of Virginia.
