The annual parade down Delaware Avenue is almost here.

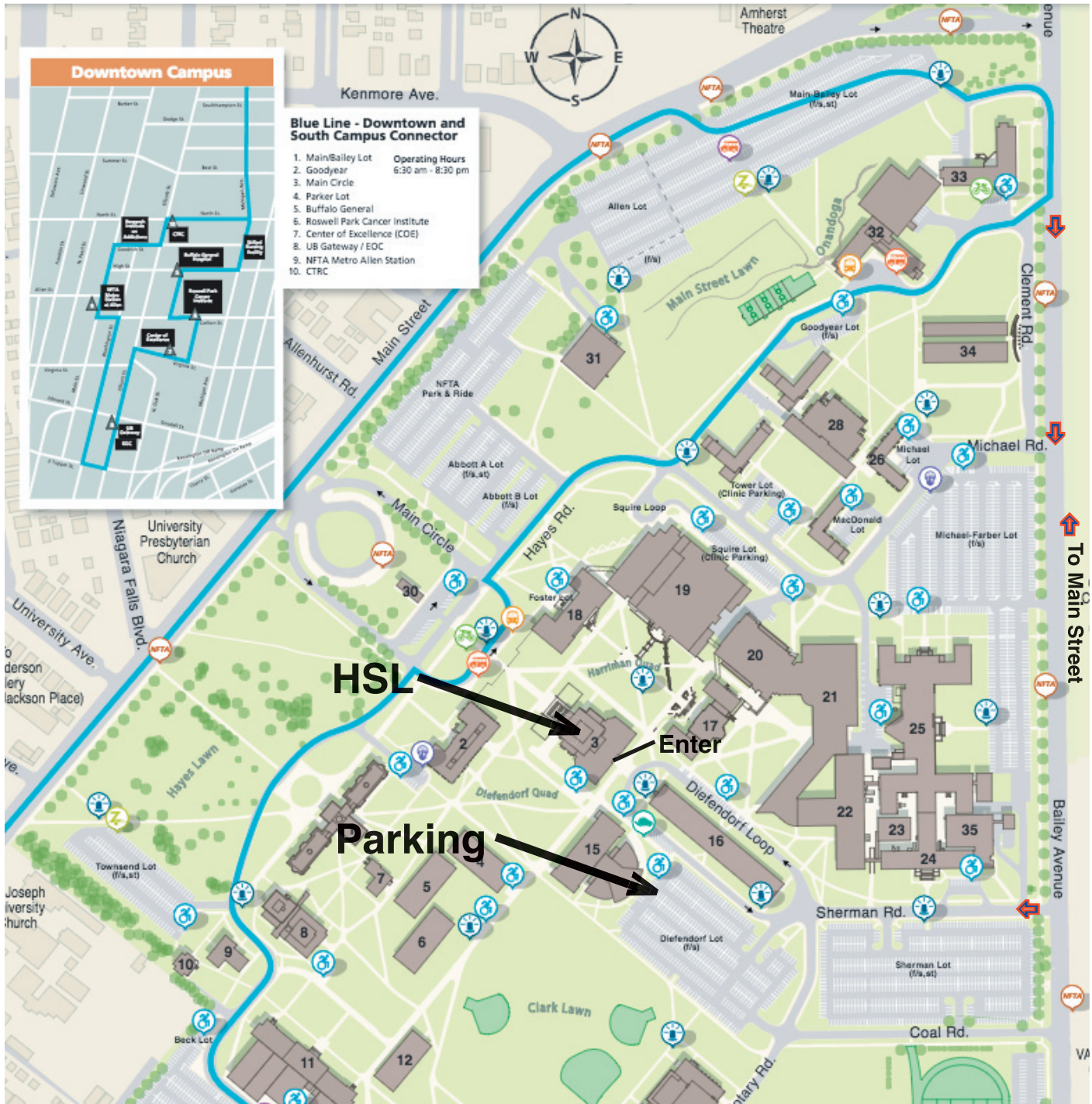
Soldiers dress in light marching order. Greatcoats may be worn as weather permits.

University at Buffalo, South Campus — GPS Coordinates: 42.953, - 78.818



The Health Sciences Library (HSL) is located in Abbott Hall on the South Campus.

From East or West: Take I-90 to I-290 West. Proceed west on I-290 to Exit 7A, Main Street West (Rte 5). Travel west about 3 miles on Main Street to Bailey Avenue (Route 62). Turn left onto Bailey, then right on Sherman Road into UB.

Parking in Diefendorf (closest) or Sherman Lots. Abbot Hall (HSL) is NW of lot. Enter HSL, turn right; elevator or stairs to basement. History of Medicine Collection is on right.
