## Accommodations

Willits-Hallowell Center, Mount Holyoke College

A block of 15 rooms at the Willits-Hallowell Center, where all of the NEMO meetings will be held, has been set aside for Thursday night, June 7, 2001. A conference rate was quoted for the overnight guestrooms: \$74.00/single and \$80.00/double. All of the rooms at the Center have two twin beds, private bath, telephone, cable-TV, and air-conditioning. Individuals will contact the Center's Front Desk (413-538-2217) directly to make their own arrangements. Tell them that you are with the NEMO Conference.

Due to the limited number of rooms at the Center (and in South Hadley), please consider sharing a room with a friend. When you call to make your reservations, either give them the name of a roommate or indicate that you are willing to share a room and have them book you with someone who has already called.

A limited number of rooms (at the same rate) are available on Wednesday, June 6, 2001 and Friday, June 8, 2001, for those people planning to arrive early and/or stay late.

## Directions

### By Car

**From the south:** Travel north on Interstate 91 to Route 202 (Exit 16, Holyoke/ South Hadley). Head north on 202 through Holyoke across the Connecticut River, and around the rotary to the exit: "South Hadley Center-Amherst, Route 116 north." The College is approximately 2.5 miles from the exit.

**From the north:** Travel south on Interstate 91, take Exit 16, and follow the directions above.

**From the Massachusetts Turnpike, east or west:** Take Exit 5 (Holyoke/Chicopee) and bear to the right. At the end of the ramp, turn left on Route 33 for five miles to Route 116. Turn right onto 116 and drive approximately 1.5 miles north to the College.

### By Train

The Amtrak station nearest to South Hadley is in Springfield, Massachusetts. Call Amtrak at 800-872-7245 for ticket prices and schedules. You can reach South Hadley by Peter Pan Bus Lines, van/car service (see below), or taxi.

### By Bus

Peter Pan offers service from Boston and New York City to South Hadley, with transfers in Springfield. For schedules and rate information, call 800-237-8747.

### By Plane

Bradley International Airport, serving Hartford, CT, and Springfield, MA is 34 miles (45 minutes) south of South Hadley on I-91. Bus service between Bradley and the College, via transfer in Springfield, is offered by Peter Pan. Call 800-237-8747 for schedules and rates. Van/car service is the easiest and most direct way to reach the College, but you must call in advance for reservations. Valley Transporter (800-872-8752 or 413-733-9700 in Mass.) picks up Terminals A and B. Another car/van service offering direct transport is Michael's Limousine Service (800-533-8470).
