### 27TH DIVISION MEN HAVE RETURNED HOME

Dunkirk and Fredonia Soldiers With Great Fighting Outfit Once More With Their Families.

Dunkirk's members of the 27th Infantry and the 14th Field Artillery, who returned from France with the 27th division, are home. They are Sergt. Jacob Schrantz, Joseph Bradley, Jewey Brooks, John Baker, Lawrence Steiner and Thomas Grawald. In the beginning of the war with the 16th Infantry, but later he transferred to the artillery regiment. All but Bradley were wounded in action. He was extremely fortunate in escaping as he was in the thick of the fighting. Alfred Ecker, Harry Walter and Anthony Baker were also with the 27th division. Ecker and Walter were installed home before the return of the division work for the entire State. He made his home at Bloomfield N. J.

He enlisted in overseas work in 1917, and was assigned to Kovalia. His most important post was at Moscow, where he remained until the overthrow of the Kerensky government, after which he went to Archangel for the "Y". Here the organization grew until a staff of fifty-five men and six women were working night and day for the needy Russians.

While at Archangel that Mr. Ryall was married to Miss Katherine Childs, of Sherman, N. Y., who also had been engaged to work there. Miss Childs was in charge of the canteen car, where she was assisted by other of the Y. M. C. A. women.

The Y. M. C. A. has already called for the command of the White House, American consul at Archangel, to get information through Stockholm if possible about the two missing "Y" men. The command was the first Y. M. C. A. secretary to be captured by the Bolshevik army.

New York, April 4.—The National War War Council of the Y. M. C. A. gave out the following statement here today regarding Bryant B. Ryall, the Y. M. C. A. secretary, who was captured by the Bolsheviks in Russia this week, and the second "Y" victim of the revolutionists in the past fortnight.

"Bryant B. Ryall was born in August, Wisconsin, was graduated from the State university there, and then came last to go into Y. M. C. A. work. In 1914 he went to Newark, N. J., as an official of the "Y" at the Newark headquarters, and was in charge of the secret work for the entire State. He made his home at Bloomfield N. J.
