
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




Part II, Problem 1 Solution The major term (P) is courageous people, The minor term (S) is investigative journalists, and The middle term (M) is social and political activists. The standard symbolic form of this syllogism is: L. Some M is not P. 2. All M is S. \therefore Some *S* is not *P*.



Part II, Problem 2 Solution The major term (P) is things that fade quickly, The minor term (S) is roses, and The middle term (\mathcal{M}) is flowers. The standard symbolic form of this syllogism is: I. Some M is P. 2. All S is M. \therefore Some S is P.
