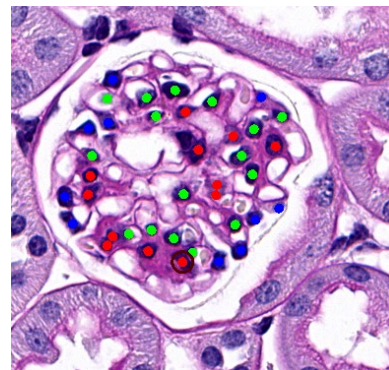
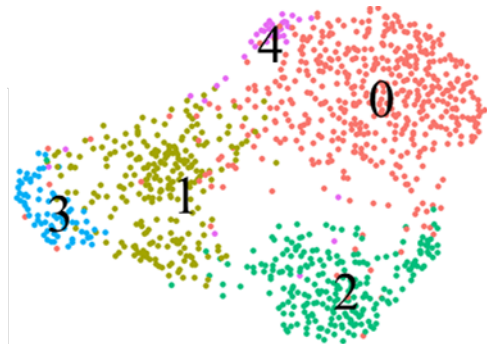
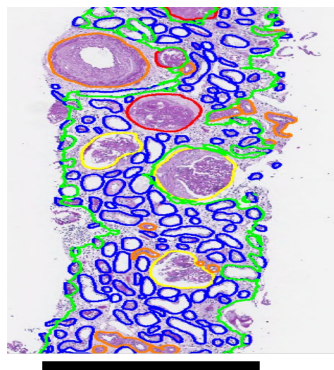




Research Scientist
